The children's program will be fully funded by sponsors which means no cost to the parents. Thank you Sponsors!



NOMINATIONS FOR BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Alberta Ready-Mixed Concrete Association needs your leadership, involvement, and support to remain a productive, creative and effective association. If you have the desire and the commitment to help shape our industry, we want to hear from you! The call for nominations for ARMCA's 2014-2015 Board of Directors is open. There is one (1) seat to be filled at the Annual General Meeting on May 8th, 2014; that of an Independent Producer for the remaining two years (May 2014 to May 2016) of a three year term to replace an elected Director that resigned in December 2013.

The Nomination Process for the ARMCA Board of Directors

ARMCA's bylaws can be found on the association's website at: http://www.armca.ca under the "members only" section.

As outlined in the bylaws, ARMCA can have a maximum of 13 Directors on the Board. Directors serve a term of 3 years but shall be eligible for re-election if otherwise qualified. The terms of the Directors are staggered so that three new Directors shall be elected each year; plus however many are required to replace Directors who may for any reason have left the Board prior to the expiration of their term. In most cases, Directors spend at least one term on the Board before joining the Executive Council. The normal progression for positions on the Executive Council of the Board is one year in each term, as the Directors progress through Second Vice-President to Vice-President to President to Past-President.

Any voting member of ARMCA, in good standing, may stand for nomination to the Board of Directors by either:

- 1) Completing the Nomination & Consent Form (below) and sending it to the ARMCA office prior to the AGM.
- 2) Attending ARMCA's AGM on May 8, 2014 in Jasper, AB and being nominated from the floor.

The majority of board meetings are located in Red Deer, Alberta. Directors are responsible for their own travel costs to attend meetings.

ICF STRATEGIC PLANNING COMMITTEE

The CRMCA and two of its members, Ready Mixed Concrete Association of Ontario (RMCAO) and British Columbia Ready Mixed Concrete Association (BCRMCA), invited the top ICF companies to a one-on-one meeting to see if there was agreement and synergy between both industries to develop and implement a national marketing strategy that could extend to all of North America. This group consists of eight of the major ICF block manufacturers, and has been created to develop a long term strategy to market ICF to the three to eight storey plus construction market. An industry survey was conducted to determine a benchmark for future measurement of market program success. Planning is underway to finalize marketing plans.

Six members of this group will partner with the CRMCA to sponsor the CHBA Annual Conference in Whistler, BC in April. This sponsorship will place them in direct contact with some of the more influential builders in Canada.

THE GREAT NORTHERN CONCRETE TOBOGGAN RACE

CONGRATULATIONS UNIVERSITY OF ALBERTA "Moo of A" – WINNERS OF THE CSCE CUP!

The **Great Northern Concrete Toboggan Race** (**GNCTR**) is an annual event that challenges the creativity of engineering students. The project involves designing and constructing a toboggan with a metal frame and a running surface made completely out of **concrete**. The sled must weigh less than 300 pounds (136 kg), have a working braking system, and be fitted with a roll bar to protect five of its team members. Each competing team must prepare a technical report summarizing the design, which is presented at a public technical exhibition. It is traditional for teams to choose a theme for their sled, complete with appropriate costumes, and incorporate elements of the design into their technical exhibit and sled aesthetics. This has become a major part of the competition, making up a large part of the spirit award, as well as the best uniforms award. Theme ideas are most often drawn from pop culture or retro references, or based on the team's home university and its location.

This year the event was hosted by Western University and held at the Boler Mountain Ski Club in London, Ontario, where approximately 450 engineering students and alumni across Canada paired up for the February 1st race.

AWARDS:

Teams are judged for top speed, best run, most improved team, braking, and aesthetics. Each year an award is also given for the best overall entry.

The University of Alberta was awarded "Overall Champion"


